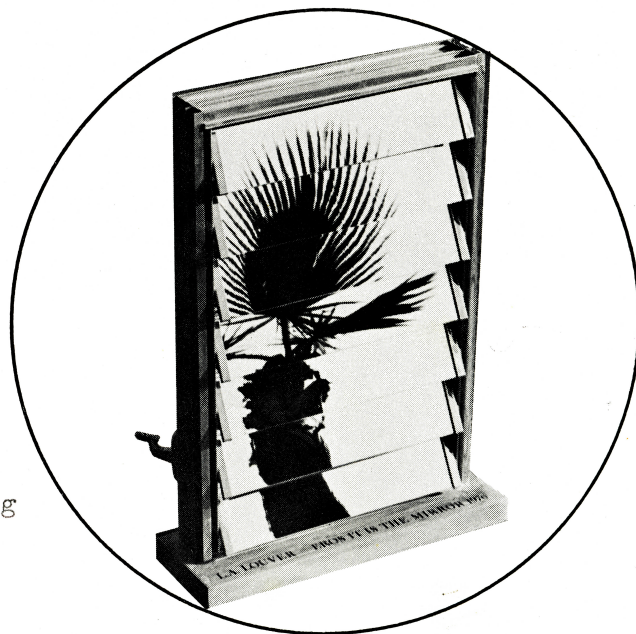

L.A.LOUVER is pleased to announce the forth-coming one-person exhibition of Sculpture and Drawings by ROBERT JANZ.



Robert Janz is a British sculptor who resides and teaches in London. For the past fifteen years he has been preoccupied with an art of change.

"The nomadic spirit is as old as humanity, and is expressed through an art that is fundamental to many cultures. It is work which we, with our over-emphasis on hardware and bigness, have largely neglected to celebrate. The nomadic is expressed through an art of changing, repeating, evolving forms. In my own particular work, there is a concern with form that changes form, sculpture that is structured to be rearranged, or drawings that are intended to be relocated. My transient street drawings and sculptural instalations activate the potential energy of disregarded and even despised corners of the world. Such works are often moved, redrawn, or reinstalled; thus they continue amidst the cycle of street changes in which they play an expressive part."

The exhibition in the gallery opens on March 25 and will run through April 23. Since his arrival in February, Robert has been working in the streets of L.A. Photographs and additional biographical information are available upon request. Thankyou for your attention.
